

Sports rules

PARA MORAVIA CUP

League rules

- The competition must include races for both sitting and standing athletes participating in field events
- The league must be recalculated at each meeting according to the World Para Athletics Points Scores for field events for the year
- In addition to announcing the best athletes at individual meetings in the given categories,
- there will also be announced the overall best PMC athlete at the end of each meeting. Person,
- who gained the most total points according to the recalculation in the competition (man and woman sitting, man and woman standing)
- At the last of all 5 races there will be an announcement of overall winners (man and woman sitting, man and woman standing)
- The worst performance or non-participation in one of the races of each athlete will be deleted. So 4 races will be calculated.
- The highest point value in the competition is counted in the final ranking of the athlete
- Athletes can compete in two or three disciplines, it depends on the organizer,
- how many disciplines are possible for one athlete.
- The same starting fee for Czechs and Slovaks (with regard to the common Czech-Slovak league) is different for foreign athletes. Need to agree

Rules for athletes

- Races are according to the valid IPC rules:

- The athlete must compete with valid and approved equipment
- An athlete racing on a shot put throwing chair must comply with all the rules related

- Athletes compete in two or three disciplines, it depends on the organizer how many disciplines are announced for one athlete
- Sitting athletes complete 2/3 of the training attempts and then 6 competition attempts
- Standing athletes where there are more than 8 athletes, they will have 3 attempts. The best 8 athletes will qualify to the finals, there will be 3 final attempts
- Only assistants who are entitled to it according to the classification can enter the sports sector

Necessary equipment, things, race assistants

- help of referees, soldiers, students, helpers
- Referee (each sector, at least 1)
- Assistants (each sector, at least 2)
- Provision of ITO (Technical Delegate)
- Provision of a moderator
- Provision of buffet, refreshments

To the sectors

- Frames; throwing chair attachment
- Ratchet Straps (4x each sector)
- equipment: Javelin 600, 700,800
 - Discuss 1kg, 1,5kg, 1,75kg, 2kg
 - Shot put 2kg, 3kg, 4kg, 5kg, 6kg, 7,26kg
 - Club 3,97g-410g (usually everyone has their own)
- Lines, sector designation
- Flags
- Tape measure, at least one metal for recording records
- Markers
- Podium
- Referee tables
- Vests for assistants
- Race bib (number)

- Call room, meeting room
- Throwing chair check (measuring instrument 75cm)

Propositions should include

- Name of the race
- Date of race
- Race location
- Disciplines
- Categories
- Competition director, main judge, persons who will help to manage in the competition
- Applications: where, by when, etc.
- Competition office
- Call room
- Call room time
- Schedule: after closing applications
- Protests
